## Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals

The Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals database offers a comprehensive listing of journal articles on architecture and design, including bibliographic descriptions on subjects such as the history and practice of architecture, landscape architecture, city planning, historic preservation, and interior design and decoration. It contains more than 440,000 thousand entries surveying over seven hundred American and international journals. These include not only scholarly and popular periodical literature, but also publications of professional associations, American state and regional periodicals, and the major serials on architecture and design of Europe, Asia, Latin America, and Australia. Articles are included from key publications such as *American Architect*, *Baumeister*, *Byggekunst*, *Domus*, and *El Croquis*, as well as architectural articles from art and planning journals such as *American Art Journal*, *Burlington Magazine*, *Environment and Planning A*, *Metropolitan Museum Journal*, and *Revue de l'Art*.

Avery Index also contains references to more than thirteen thousand obituary citations thereby providing architects, architectural historians, and researchers with an excellent source of biographical and professional information about architects. Among the obituaries indexed are those from four crucial American periodicals since their inception: *American Architect* (1876), *Architectural Forum* (1892), *Architectural Record* (1891), and *Progressive Architecture* (1920). The *Journal of the Royal Institute of British Architects* is indexed as far back as 1865, providing an extensive record of English architects.
